CUB SCOUT MEMBERSHIP BADGES

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Requirements for the Cub Scout Membership Badge Age 7 – 11 years

The Cub Scout should know the following -

1. Cub Scout Promise and Law –

- I. To know the Cub Scout Promise
- II. To know the Cub Scout Law

2. Motto

To able to say the motto

3. Smartness:

To know how to stand at ease and attention positions

4. Salute and Hand Shake

To know the Cub Scout Salute & left hand shake correctly.

5. Grand Yell

To know how to perform the grand yell.

6. Jungle Story

To know the story up to admission of Mowgli to the pack

7 Good Deed

Report verbally to the Akela a good deed done by the Cub Scout

8 Two months service after joining the Pack.

It is the Cub Scout Master/Mistress who recommends that the Cub Scout has successfully completed the requirements for the membership.

BRONZE STAR BADGES

Requirements for the Bronze Star

7 years & 2 months – 11 years

1. Collecting Money in a till -

From the time the Cub Scout receives their membership they should collect money in a till until he/she receive their bronze Star.

2. Knowledge on different religion

To know the names of the main four religions in Sri Lanka and their symbols and the places of worship.

3 Happy Service

To perform a service with the pack to help others happily

Eg: - Cleaning the class-room / donating books to be library.

Making/ flower beds.

4 Reef Knot

To know how to tie the Reef knot and its uses.

5 Reading Time

Read the time on a clock.

Make a clock and read the time on it.(At least in four instances)

6 Cleaning shoes

Keep ones shoes clean (Polish if possible)

7 Scarf-

Learn to wear his /her scarf and fold it.

8 Create a Simple Art or Handwork

To know how to Create a simple hand work or to draw a picture.

(An exhibition could be done on a later date)

9 National Anthem

Recite the National Anthem and know the correct way of standing when it is sung.

10 Observation - (Flowers and birds)

Observe 3 kinds of flowers and 3 different birds found in his home/ area and verbally report to the Akela.

11 Acting

Performing an act in front of Akela. Showing how a particular animal moves or presenting a character in a story. **eg:** Bunny hop, how Mahadana Muttha walks, how a hawk is flying fast.

12 Catching and throwing a ball

Participating with cub scouts in a game which involves catching and throwing a ball.

13 Skipping

Skip forward 15 times and backwards 5 times with a standard skipping rope.

14 Leap frog

Perform the leap frog correctly with another Cub Scout suitable for his height.

15 Good Health habits

Write good health habits in a Bristol board & exhibit in School and participate in a health procession/parade

16 Details of family

To know the home address and the telephone number, details about himself/herself and about his family and report to Akela verbally.

17 Road Safety

To learn to walk safely how to cross the road. and collect information regarding road safety & report to Akela verbally.

18 Serving Food

With the help of the Akela, make sandwiches with his six and serve it.

19 Scout songs

Sing two scout songs with his six.

20 Religious ceremony

To take part in a religious ceremony in his own place of worship and report it to Akela.

21 Commands

Practice commands he has learnt up to now.

1. Stand at ease and attention
2. Turn left
3. Turn right
4. About turn
5. Disperse
6. Salute

22 Jungle Story

From Mowgli entering the pack to being rescued by Kaa the python.

23 Six months Service

Complete **six** months service after passing the membership.

• COMPULSORY PROFICIENCY BADGES

Book reader & Artist

- He/she can win this star after the ages of 7 years and 8 months and before 11 years old.
- Other than the two compulsory badges he can also attempt 2 proficiency badges from the following –
Musician / Entertainer / Hobbies / Cyclist / Athlete
- The recommendation will be given by the Cub Scout Master/Mistress that the Cub Scout has successfully completed all the requirements and has qualified for the Bronze Star.

SILVER STAR BADGE BADGE

Requirements for the Silver Star

Age - 8 years 2 months to 11 years

1. A Bank Account –

Saving money and depositing in a Savings Account. (Start a savings account if he / she does not have one),

2. Religious Activity

Participating in an activity of his/ her own religion.

eg: Observing the Eight Precepts on Poya days, Taking part in 'Novena' in church, Pooja in a Hindu Temple, Fasting during Ramazan

3. Thrift (Clothes and books)

Understand how to use you own your equipment such as clothes books etc without wasting them.

1. **Clothes** - Wash and dry one's own school uniform or scout uniform using soap, (during the pack meeting)
2. **Books** – Learn how to use his/her school books and the bag in a proper manner
3. To put a cover to a book or make a book mark.

4. Stitching a button

To thread a needle and stitch a button on a piece of cloth. (Button should have at least 2 holes)

5. Greeting

- To know the forms of greeting at different times.
Eg: Good Morning / Good Night etc.
- To know the forms of greeting at different events.
All cubs to make a Greeting Card during Cub time and write a greeting
Eg : For Birthday/Vesak Festival/Christmas/Eid Mubarak

6. Respecting

- To know when and how he/she should respect / honour elders and Present if with his/her six

7. Sheet – bend.

To know how to tie the sheet bend and its uses.

8. Preparing Tea -

As a six making a cup of tea and learning the proper presentation of serving it.

9. Journey

Visit a special place around his/her school with the pack eg – Police Station / Post Office / Flower Garden and explaining its importance.

10. National Flag

To know to stand at attention when the national flag is hoisted and not to misuse it.

11. Observation_(Trees and Fish)

Observe 3 kinds of trees and 03 kinds of quadrupeds and report to Akela about their importance.

12. Creativity

Make a creative object that could be used in day to day life. Be creative- Using throw away materials or natural /environmentally friendly materials

Eg: Making a pen holder from a thrown away salmon tin.

13. Folk Songs –

Singing two folk songs with the Pack

14. A Great Character

To perform a act with his six about a great character in history

Eg: Madduma Bandara, Weera Puran Appu, hon. Hon.D S.Senanayake, Pandith Amaradewa etc.

15. Obstacle course

Participate in an activity with obstacles.

eg: Creeping through a tyre, Jumping over an obstacle, creeping under a chair.

16. Smartness –

Marking time and Marching

17. Acting to a song in a drama.

Acting while singing a song in a drama with his sixes.

18. Somersault / Cart wheel

Perform somersault or overhead cart wheel individually. .

19. Balancing

Walking a distance of about eight (08) meters keeping a weight of about one kilogram on the head. (Use a book or a covered half brick)

20. Foreign Scout song and a Yell

Presenting by Sixes or as a Pack, a foreign Scout Song and a Yell.

21. The Jungle Story

Knowing the jungle story from the scene where Kaa rescues Mowgli up to the red flower being brought to Seone forest

22. District or National Activity

Participation in a cub scout day, District Cub Scout Rally or a Cubboree.

23. Six Months service after completing the Bronze Star Badge

Compulsory Proficiency Badges

House orderly and Gardener Badges are mandatory.

- Silver Star could be won only after 08 years and 02 months of age and before Completing 11 years.
- If required the he/she Cub Scout is able to win 04 more Proficiency Badges other than the following, First Aider,

Guide, Happy Home, Energy conservation, Computer and Environment Badges

- The recommendation will be given by the Cub Scout Master/Mistress that the Cub Scout has successfully completed all the requirements and has qualified for the Silver Star.

GOLD STAR BADGE

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GOLD STAR

Age 9– 11 years

1. Cub Scout prayer/ reflection

To participate in a multi religious programme organized by the Akela.

2. Scrap Book –

Press 10 varieties of leaves and flowers each and paste on a black drawing book/ a book that has been used, and name them. (During the pack meeting)

3. Happy service

Engage in a happy service in a place close to school (duration 01 hour)

eg: Doing something useful in a place of religious importance or a public/common place.

4. Round – turn and two half hitches -

To know how to tie Round – turn and two half hitches and its uses.

5. Clove – hitch

To know how to tie Clove – hitch and its uses.

6. Cooking –

Prepare one of the food mentioned below. Boil sweet-potatoes/ manioc / yams / gram etc and serve it.

7. Ironing clothes

Be able to iron his/her shirt or dress

8. Sense – training games

Participate in three Sense – training games organize by the Akela.

9. Ramble

Participate in a Ramble and a Treasure Hunt with his six for half a day.

10. Advertisement –

Participate with his six and act out an advertisement relevant to children using Positive attitudes.

11. Nature picture

Draw a picture from one of the following from the environment.
Eg: a tree / Sea – beach / a hill / a paddy field / Flower Garden

12. Dramatizing a Children’s play

To perform a drama with his/ her six on a theme given by the Akela for 3 minutes

13. Climbing a Tree or a rope

Climbing a Rope or a tree to the height of 03 meters. Please ensure necessary safety precautions.

14. First Aid –

- Prepare a First – Aid kit with 06 items. Identify items necessary to dress a simple wound and the way to use them.

15. Study Uses

With another friend, study any two of the following and explain to the Akela orally the uses of them.

- I. Public Library
- II. Museum
- III. Zoological Garden
- IV. Super Market
- V. A Village Fair
- VI. A Farm
- VII. A Carpentry work- shop
- VIII. A village Smith’s Workshop
- IX. A Post Office
- X. Harbour
- XI. Swimming Pool
- XII. Tea Factory etc

16. Red Flower

Participate actively in a 'Red Flower' Program organized by the akela.

17. Three Yells

Perform three yells individually.

18. The Founder – B. P the following facts about B. P.

Know about B. P.

- Date of birth of BP
- Birth place of BP
- First scout camp
- Beginning of the cub scout section
- Place he passed away

19. Holiday Camp

Participate in a Pack Holiday Camp for one night with his/ her own pack .

20. The Jungle Story

Know the story from "Bringing the Red Flower" up to bringing the skin of the tiger.

21. Compulsory Six (06) Months service after the date of completing the Silver Star

Compulsory Proficiency badges

Happy Home, First - Aider and Guide.

- This Star could be won after completing 9 years of age and before completing 11 years.
- Cub Scout may attempt another 03 Proficiency Badges before he wins the gold star.
- After winning the Gold Star, he / she may win the rest of the Proficiency Badges, if desired.
- He/she will be eligible for the Gold Star only after successfully being interviewed by the Asst. District Commissioner cubs of the District.
- Log Book will not be required for the Gold star interview.
