

Resolutions

The Sri Lanka Scout Association, District Commissioner's Conference 2020 held on 11th July 2020 at the Kothalawela Defence University unanimously passed the following Resolutions:-

No. 01 of 2020 – To adopt and implement the Strategic Plan proposed by the Chief Commissioner for 2020-2022

No. 02 of 2020 – To introduce the 7 badges to the Scouts of Sri Lanka which was introduced under Better World Framework of the World Organisation of the Scout Movement;

No. 03 of 2020 - for the said purpose to form 7 focus teams consisting of Senior Scouts, Rover Scouts, Scout Leaders and Commissioners

No. 4 of 2020 - To include the Sash as part and parcel of the Junior and Senior Scout uniform

No. 5 of 2020 – To Form Disaster Response and Management Teams in all districts

No 6 of 2020 – To appoint an ADC or DSL for Media and IT

No 7 of 2020 – To form a Media Unit in every District

No. 8 of 2020 – To appoint a Co-ordinator for Better World Framework in every District

No. 9 of 2020 – To appoint a Co-ordinator for Safe from Harm in every District

No. 10 of 2020 – To limit the period of the Badge Secretary of a District to a maximum period of 5 years

No. 11 of 2020 – To introduce a Handbook for Badge Secretary

No. 12 of 2020 – To discontinue the use of Log Books for Cub Scouts

No. 13 of 2020 – To introduce an Activity Book and Scout Hand Book

No. 14 of 2020 – To limit the period of service of Assistant District Commissioners to two terms of 5 years totaling to 10 years and in the event of a specific requirement to extend at the request of the District Commissioner under special circumstances for a maximum period of one term and no more.

No. 15 of 2020 – To improve the Quality of Scouting in Sri Lanka

The Following Suggestions were proposed and unanimously accepted by the Conference

1. To request the Committee of the Council to ascertain who the responsible Commissioners/officials are in causing a monetary loss to the SLSA on account of the 24th World Scout Jamboree in USA and what action is proposed to recover the said loss
2. Send a notice to the District President and the DC, three months prior to the end of the terms of the DC.
3. To increase the percentage given to the district, from Service & Relationship Week.
4. Help districts to build/ maintain district headquarters.
5. Introduce a common Act & Rules to all district associations which do not have their constitution
6. Introduce a National Scout Song
7. Introduce Position Descriptions to District Commissioners/ District Officials.
8. Scout Commissioners/ officials not to engage in active politics. If they are contesting for an election, has to resign from the posts been held in Scouting.
9. Scout Commissioners and Officials to refrain from commenting on political, racial and religious views and posts on Social Media
10. To look into the financial losses of the Scout Shop and make available all items and badges required for scouts at reasonable prices
