Jamboree Denmark 2026 (18th July to 26th July 2026)

We are pleased to inform you that the International Division of the Sri Lanka Scout Association is now calling for applications to participate in the Jamboree Denmark 2026, scheduled to be held from 18th July to 26th July 2027 in Hedeland Nature Park, Denmark.

Youth participants (Scouts) must be between 12 and 17 years of age at the time of the event (born after 18 July 2008 and not later than 18 July 2014). Individuals 18 years and above (born on or before 18 July 2008) are eligible to apply as Adult Scout Leaders and members of the Contingent Management Team (CMT).

Please note that this is a physical, in-person event. All participating Scouts and adult leaders are required to bear the cost of airfare, Jamboree participation fees, visa fees, and any other related expenses. The responsibility for booking air tickets and obtaining the relevant visa rests entirely with the individual participant. The Sri Lanka Scout Association will not be responsible for airfare arrangements or visa processing. Further details are provided in the annexure attached to this circular.

Eligible and interested applicants are requested to complete the Overseas Events Application Form, duly recommended by the Group Scout Leader/School Principal and District Commissioner. Completed applications should be sent by registered post to: Sri Lanka Scout Association, 65/9, Sir Chittampalam A. Gardiner Mawatha, Colombo 02.

Please indicate “**Jamboree Denmark 2026**” on the top left corner of the envelope. All applications must reach the National Scout Headquarters on or before 10th February 2026.

Event name	Jamboree Denmark 2026
Event details	<p>When 30,000 Guides and Scouts, together with volunteers from around the world, come together for Jamboree Denmark 2026, the experience will be about much more than camping, sleeping in tents, and cooking over an open fire, although these remain an essential and exciting part of Scouting life.</p> <p>The Jamboree aims to offer something deeper and more meaningful. It seeks to create a week where every Scout feels included, valued, and heard, and where each participant becomes an important part of a global Scouting community. Through shared activities, cultural exchange, and teamwork, Scouts will build friendships, learn from one another, and experience the true spirit of international Scouting.</p>
Dates	18 th to 26 th July 2026
Event Venue	<p>Hedeland Nature Park, Denmark.</p> <p>Hedeland Nature Park is located on the outskirts of Copenhagen, between the towns of Roskilde, Hedehusene, and Taastrup, in eastern Denmark.</p> <p>From Copenhagen Airport (Kastrup), Hedeland Nature Park is approximately 45–50 km west of the airport. Travel time is usually 45 minutes to 1 hour, depending on the mode of transport and traffic conditions.</p>
Eligibility of Participants	<p>Youth participants (Scouts) must be between 12 and 17 years of age at the time of the event (born after 18 July 2008 and not later than 18 July 2014).</p> <p>Individuals 18 years and above (born on or before 18 July 2008) are eligible to apply as Adult Scout Leaders and members of the Contingent Management Team (CMT) members.</p>
Adherence to Ministry of Education requirements	<p>Scouts from government schools are advised to form patrols consisting of nine Scouts (which may include members from different schools) along with one Adult Scout Leader who must be a government school teacher.</p> <p>In the case of semi-government and private schools, the same composition must be adhered to.</p> <p>Please note that this is a mandatory requirement for the selection of Scouts, in accordance with Ministry of Education guidelines. Scouts who are unable to meet this requirement will not be eligible for inclusion in the contingent.</p>

Event Fee / Registration fee	2600 DKK (DKK = Danish Krone)
Airfare	Approximately LKR 400,000.00 from Colombo to Copenhagen, Denmark Please note: All prices are highly subject to significant changes due to airfare fluctuations.
Visa fee + Visa handling fee	Visa Fee: LKR 42,800.00, payable through VFS Global in Colombo and Visa will be handled by Royal Norwegian Embassy in New Delhi and Consulate General in Mumbai India Visa Handling Fee: LKR 25,000.00, payable through a travel agent. Applicants must possess a valid passport at the time of the interview, with validity up to at least 31 st July 2027.
Travel and medical insurance	Participants are required to obtain travel and medical insurance covering the entire period of their stay outside Sri Lanka (approximately LKR 10,000). Please note that this medical insurance does not cover pre-existing health conditions.
NHQ Administration fee and Overseas Jamboree fund	LKR 5,000 (non-refundable): This fee covers the SLSA scarf, SLSA shoulder patches, Sri Lanka flag for the uniform, and all administrative work at the National Scout Headquarters (NHQ).
Additional costs / Post Jamboree Tour	Participants will be responsible for any additional costs related to transportation, food, and accommodation before and after the event. The estimated cost of the post-Jamboree tour is approximately USD 200.
Contingent merchandise	The contingent T-shirt, contingent bag, contingent water bottle, and contingent badge will be produced, and each participant is required to purchase and pay for the contingent merchandise.
Training camps	The costs of the training camps must be borne by the participants.
VISA and Air ticket disclaimer form	All participants must sign a disclaimer and acknowledge that they are personally responsible for obtaining their visa and arranging their air tickets. The Sri Lanka Scout Association (SLSA) will not be responsible for these, as visas are issued by the embassy based on the individual circumstances of each participant. However, SLSA will assist participants by providing guidance and supporting documents for obtaining visas and arranging air tickets.
Surety bond	All participants are required to sign a surety bond to guarantee their return to Sri Lanka after the Jamboree. The bond will be

	<p>executed between SLSA and the participants (for minors, it will be signed jointly with their parents).</p> <p>The surety bond amounts must be submitted to NHQ at the time of signing: LKR 500,000 for Adult Scout Leaders, IST members, and CMT members and LKR 300,000 for Youth Participants (Scouts)</p>
